### BLACK ASH BASKET:

4-Day Workshop  
Learn to pound a black ash tree to loosen the fiber splints, split the fibers and weave a large hamper with handles.

## clay: tile making

These classes will focus on using slips for color, instead of glazes.

Anyone wanting to glaze must arrange a special session after tile is fired. Two-week turn around time for each tile session.

Learn slab creation. Impressions of leaves, flower petals, other found objects. Create up to 4 tiles. Paint on slip.

Create wonderful patterns on fabric - silk and cotton. A great workshop for quilters or fiber artists.

### ADVANCED SILK PAINTING

**TECHNIQUES: 2-Day workshop**  
Students will learn to use many silk painting methods, watercolor, resist, salt, sugar, and shibori in the same painting. Microwave & steam setting of acid dyes.

**DYE SILK RIBBON:** used for knitting/weaving/embellishing  
Workshop will dye 90 yards of habotai silk ribbon using the arashi shibori method. Shibori is a traditional Japanese form of pleating, folding, twisting and wrapping fiber with string to resist the flow of the dye.

**ARASHI SHIBORI ON SILK**  
Shibori is a traditional Japanese form of pleating, folding, twisting and wrapping fiber with string to resist the flow of the dye. Steam setting dyes using the microwave. Dye a 8" x 50" chiffon scarf.

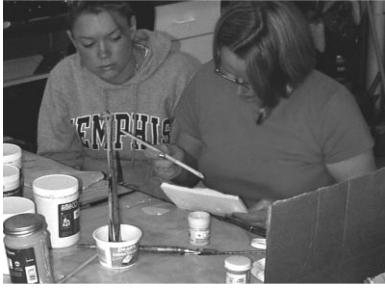
