Spun locally in northern Michigan at Stonehedge Fiber Mill in East Jordan, the yarns are a blend of rare, luster longwools produced by the special sheep of our neighbors, The Loubert Family at the Lake View Farm near Cross Village Michigan. Hand painted by Joann Condino and fellow artisans at Three Pines Studio with uniquely formulated dye colors. The yarns are a celebration of the colors and textures of this unique Great Lakes region.

The Colors of Crooked Tree Yarn project is beginning its 6th year. We continue our efforts to support a sustainable farm-to-market enterprise in Cross Village, Michigan.

Our yarn may be purchased every Wednesday at the Harbor Springs Market, at the Fiber Arts Festival at Castle Farm (July 28 & 29) and, of course, daily at Three Pines Studio.
